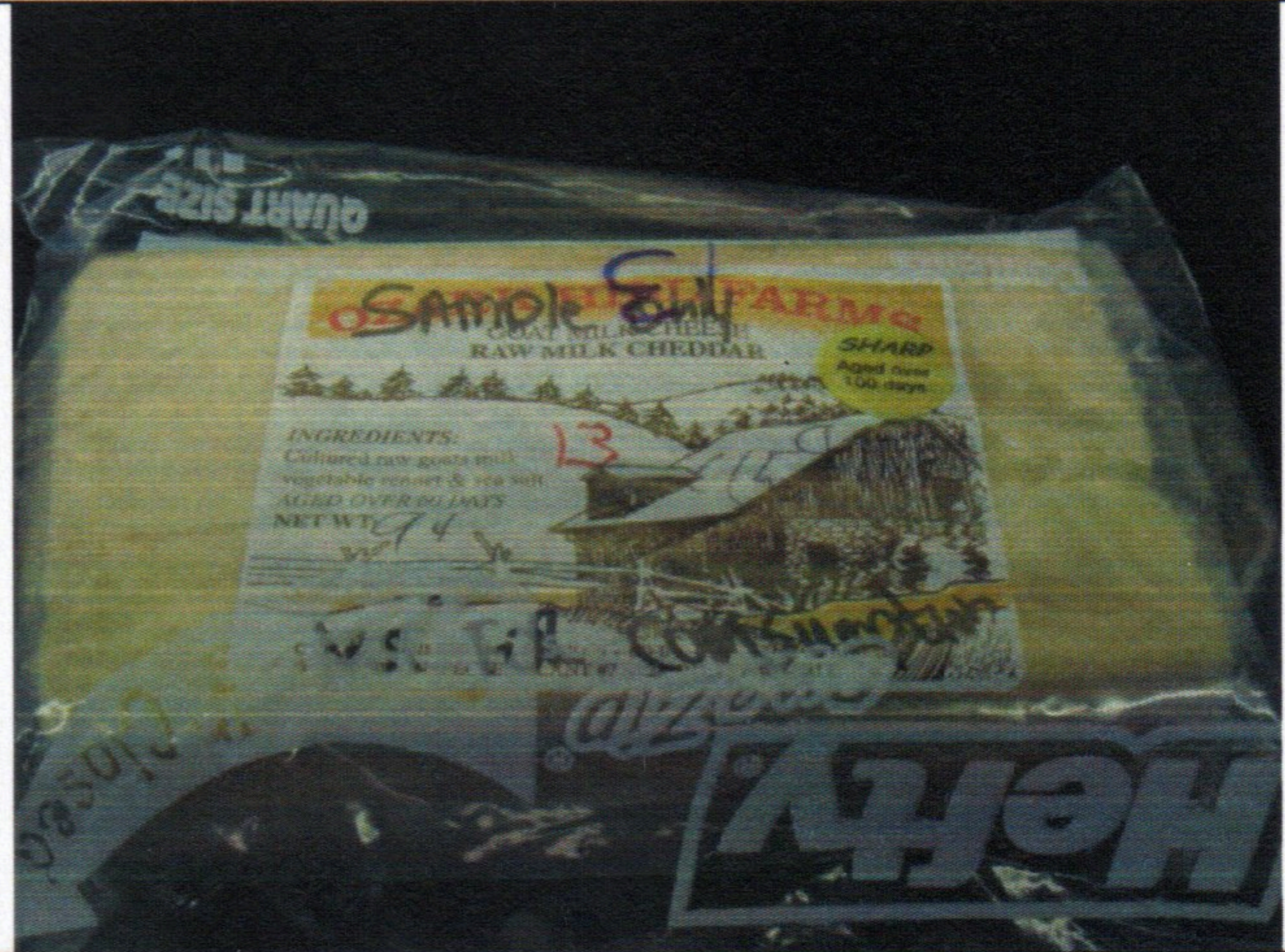




Sample 2 removed from quart bag (10/15/10)
