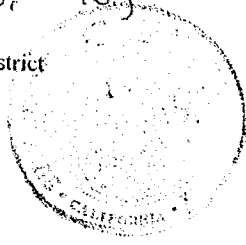

Business of RAWESOME FOODS
665 Rose Avenue

The business of **RAWESOME FOODS** is located at 665 Rose Avenue, Venice, California 90291-2716. The business is located in the City of Los Angeles and described as an open air community market specializing in raw organic produce, meats, poultry and unpasteurized dairy products. Records indicate the property owner is McCoy Family Trust and the property is described as a vacant commercial lot.

The business is located on the west side of the 600 block of Rose Avenue. It has a ten foot high silver corrugated metal fence extending the length of the property on Rose Avenue. The address numbers 665 appear in white colored numbers on the side of the corrugated metal siding with a sign identifying "Rawesome Foods" listing the business days and hours underneath the numbers. Entrance to the interior courtyard is through a corrugated metal gate. The interior of the lot contains separate multiple wood structures which support an office, cashiers booth and stand for the produce products. Inside the courtyard is a separate silver metal walk-in freezer which houses perishable dairy products. The property extends to an alley on the west side of the courtyard that is secured with a sliding metal gate to allow for truck deliveries.

The search of the premises is to include all rooms, attics, basements, files, desks, refrigerators, freezers, and other parts therein; the surrounding grounds, garages, vehicles, storage areas, trash containers, freezers, refrigerators, and outbuildings of any kind located therein, specifically the structure designated as the office and any combination safes or locked boxes, including all purses and wallets found in the care, custody, and/or control and dominion of Rawesome Foods or owner/ proprietor James Stewart.

The search is to include all automated/computer information systems, and listening to, noting and recording of any messages left on any telephone answering device or tape recorders located therein.

PROPERTY TO BE SEIZED

All personal property and documents used for a means of identification for the business of Rawesome Foods, Healthy Family Farms, suspect Sharon Palmer and owner/proprietor James Stewart including business license, public health license, sales records, livestock ownership paperwork, shipping invoices, driver's licenses, credit card receipts, equipment purchase documents, service receipt documents, and any and all documents pertaining to said business including those belonging to the Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) Membership program.

Any articles of personal property tending to establish ownership over the premises to be searched, automobiles, or items to be seized, including all keys to the described locations, rent

receipts, mortgage coupon books, utility bills, telephone bills, addressed mail, purchase receipts, sales receipts, vehicle pink slips, correspondence with insurance companies regarding policies and claims and vehicle registration certificates and all documents pertaining to CSA Membership information.

Any documents showing assets in the United States or any foreign country, including business records, blank or pre-signed rent receipts, letters, envelopes, bank and savings account records, investment records, cancelled checks (real or counterfeit), balance sheets, safe deposit boxes, large sums of money, money order receipts (real or counterfeit), wire transfer receipts, any and all real estate transactions including loan documents, bankruptcy records, and travelers checks (real or counterfeit). Any financial documents showing the money trail of any sales transactions and unreported or underreported income.

All records or documents, correspondence, receipts, business ledgers, bank statements, cancelled checks, inventory or contracts, business tax records, bankruptcy records, regarding other businesses where **SHARON ANN PALMER** and **JAMES STEWART** work or own a business.

All articles of personal property and documents used by the persons named as a means of employment including personnel records, pre-employment applications, employment records, employee benefit packages, pay stubs, time cards, employee identifications, employee tax returns, union records, signature cards, and emergency notification cards.

Any of the aforementioned evidence whether found in printed/documentary form or contained on electronic storage devices capable of storing electronic data, including magnetic tapes and disks (floppy or hard), personal digital assistants (PDA's), zip drives, CD-Rom and DVD, telephone answering services such as a voice mail and/or cassette tapes used for messages. Computer(s) and/or computer systems(s) necessary to retrieve the electronic data, including the Central Processing Unit (CPU), monitor or viewing screen (CRT), printers, scanners, keyboards, digital equipment, disk or tape drive(s), and any other data storage devices and peripheral devices needed to operate and access the computer(s) and/or computer system(s). This is to include all manuals for the operation of the computer(s) and/or computer system(s) and all other peripheral devices, together with all handwritten notes and passwords that may be attached or in close proximity and/or printed material(s) related to the operation of the computer(s) and/or computer system(s).

Various samples of the dairy products present will be taken for laboratory analysis. These shall include but will not be limited to cheese, cream, milk, whey, yoghurt, butter, kefir, and any other product deemed necessary for testing.

Copies of sales receipts and electronic mail communications from any and all business transactions where dairy products were sold by Healthy Family Farms to include the counties of Los Angeles, Ventura, Kern, Santa Barbara, San Luis Obispo, and any other location in or across the United States.

After representative samples have been obtained for laboratory analysis, the remaining products will be the responsibility of the Public Health Department, Food and Milk Program. All dairy and produce products on the premises will be subject to being seized or destroyed according to the applicable health codes by the State of California and County of Los Angeles Public Health.

The crime period is from January 1, 2009 to Present Day.

This search, as to the above persons and premises, is to include the taking of photographs and/or video of the individuals and premises (interior and exterior) for identification purposes.
